

Only two blocks from the Sheraton, the Hyatt Regency Chicago will handle overflow housing. Bordering the "Magnificent Mile," the Hyatt Regency Chicago is the largest property in the Hyatt hotel chain and the largest hotel in the city. The Hyatt Regency Chicago is located just off Michigan Avenue, along Chicago's Riverwalk overlooking the river and Lake Michigan. Rates

Conference lodging rates are exclusive of applicable taxes. This special NTP conference rate is 2.5% (\$4.00) over the FY 2003 GSA established government per diem rate for lodging in Chicago. The General Services Administration (GSA) has amended the Federal Travel Regulation (FTR) rates governing conferences. This regulation provides a conference lodging allowance of up to 25 percent greater than the applicable locality-lodging portion of the per diem rate. Under this reimbursement method, employees may be reimbursed the actual amount incurred for lodging up to the conference lodging allowance.

Reservations

To reserve a room at the special NTP rate at either of these hotels. contact the hotel directly. After June 3, 2003, FEW cannot guarantee availability of rooms or the special conference rate. All reservations will require a credit card to guarantee the reservation. Reservations must be canceled by April 30, 2003, to avoid a penalty charge equal to one night's lodging. (Even if you make your reservation after April 30 and need to cancel, you will be charged one night's lodging as a penalty. You may substitute names at no charge.) Individuals may make no more than two reservations under a single name and credit card. Individuals wishing to reserve more than two rooms will be directed to a hotel reservations. specialist for assistance with special housing needs.

Airport and Ground Transportation

AIRPORTS

O'Hare International Airport is 45 minutes from downtown Chicago and handles more passengers than any other airport in the world. Airport information booths are located on the lower levels of the domestic terminals.

Midway Airport is 20 minutes from downtown Chicago. The one-building airport is divided into three terminals, A, B and C. The main lobby at the airport's center entrance is where the information booth and all vehicle pick-up services are available.

■ O'Hare Airport Shuttles


The shuttle departs from O'Hare every 10-15 minutes between 5:45am to 11:30pm to all downtown hotels. When returning to the airport, the shuttle departs the Sheraton Chicago at 25 minutes and 55 minutes past the hour from 4:55am to 7:10pm Allow $2^{1}/_{2}$ hours before your flight for travel and check-in.

■ Midway Airport Shuttles

The shuttle departs from Midway every 10-15 minutes between 4:45am to 10:30pm to all down-



town hotels. When returning to the airport, the shuttle departs the Sheraton Chicago at 5 minutes and 35 minutes past the hour from 6:15am to 7:45pm. Allow 1¹/₂ hours before your flight for travel and check-in.

CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY (AKA THE "L")

CTA Fares are \$1.50 per ride and subject to change. Ground transportation between the nearest station and the Sheraton is approximately a \$5.00 taxi fare and takes 5-8 minutes

■ CTA Trains to O'Hare Airport

The L is located at Lake and Clark Streets in the State of Illinois Building. The L runs every 5 minutes (BLUE LINE) and takes about 50 minutes. The last stop will be Terminal 4 of O'Hare Airport. The Blue Line serving O'Hare operates 24/7.

■ CTA Trains to Midway Airport

The L is located at Lake and Clark Streets in the State of Illinois Building. The L runs every 5 minutes (ORANGE LINE) and takes about 30 minutes. The Orange Line serving Midway operates from 4:30am to 1:00am.
